

On Thursday, July 23, 2015 at approximately 8:15pm,

The Wadena County Sheriff's Office responded to Rockwood Township for a farming accident. Deputies and Sebeka First Responders arrived on scene and saw a male with his right arm stuck in the baler. The victim was baling hay when the hay got stuck between the pick-up and the rollers. The victim attempted to clear the hay, but left the baler running while attempting to clear the hay, resulting in his right arm going through the rollers and became lodged in the rollers. Severe injuries were sustained to his right arm and he was airlifted to North Memorial Hospital.

Agencies assisting the Wadena County Sheriff's Office were Menahga Police Department, Sebeka First Responders, MN State Patrol, Tri County Ambulance and North Memorial Air Care.
