

On Wednesday, August 5, 2015, at approximately 6:59am, the Wadena County Sheriff's Office received a report of a one vehicle rollover on 280<sup>th</sup> Street, half a mile west of Sebeka.

Rylan Aho of Frazee was traveling east, driving a West Central Telephone Association service truck. He had fallen asleep and the vehicle drifted out of its lane. The driver over corrected causing the vehicle to skid out of control. The vehicle entered the south ditch and rolled over. Aho was out of the vehicle when First Responders arrived on scene.

The driver was released by ambulance personnel with no reported injuries. Assisting the Sheriff's Office was Sebeka Fire and Rescue, Tri-County Ambulance and the State Patrol.
