



On Friday, September 26th, a Wadena County Sheriff Deputy attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a vehicle on Cord 23 near Cord 15. When the deputy signaled for the vehicle to stop, the vehicle fled from the deputy, reaching speeds of 106 MPH. The incident took place around 5:40 on Friday evening and lasted for about six miles before the driver of the vehicle pulled over. The driver, 55 year old Robert Berthelot, of Sebeka, was taken into custody without further incident. Berthelot was transported to the Wadena County Jail on suspicion of Fleeing a Peace Officer, Driving Under the Influence, and Driving Without a License.
