Immunization Services

Minnesota Vaccine for Children Program

Low cost Minnesota Vaccines for Children Program is available for **children** 0-18 with no health insurance; private health insurance with no coverage for vaccine, unmet deductibles or insurance vaccine cap reached; and public health insurance recipients (MN Care, MA, PMAP, GMAC).

Selected vaccines are also available for **adults** who are uninsured or underinsured; or have public health insurance.

Additional Vaccines Available

Yearly Influenza (flu)
Hep B for employees of selected organizations

Also available

Mantoux testing for students and health care workers
(a test for tuberculosis exposure, not a vaccine)

Immunizations and mantoux testing are available at the following regularly scheduled clinics on a “walk in” basis in Wadena and a “call for appointment” basis in the other communities:

401 2nd Street SE, Sebeka
1st Monday every third month,
(Jan/April/July/October)
Call for an appointment.

At **Staples Alliance Church,**

1512 8th Street NE, Staples
2nd Tuesday every third month,
(Feb/May/Aug/Nov)
Call for an appointment.

Cost: For MN Vaccine for Children Program or adult state vaccine is an administration fee (2010: \$13.25 per shot) if you do not have public health insurance. The cost for private purchased supply is the administration fee plus the cost of the vaccine or mantoux solution.
