	ACCEPTED RECYCLABLE	HOW TO PREPARE
Plastic & Glass can be mixed	<u>Plastic Jugs/Bottles - #1 & #2</u> <i>(indicated on the bottom of jugs)</i> & a neck <u>Tubs - #2 & #4</u> <u>Bottles & Lids - #4</u>	Rinse, remove caps & rings, flatten or cut down one side and stack
	<u>Glass</u>	Rinse, remove caps * Food containers must be unbroken
Aluminum, Tin & Steel can be mixed	<u>Aluminum Pop Cans</u>	May crush to save space
	<u>Steel & Tin</u>	Rinse, may flatten to save space
	<u>Magazines -</u> Catalogs, phone books, Reader's Digest, or shiny glossy paper	Boxed or Bundled
Paper,	<u>Cardboard -</u> Corrugated only	Flattened, boxed, or bundled
Cardboard, & Cloth	<u>Cloth</u>	Clean, odor free, bundled
	<u>Paper -</u> Newspaper, office & computer	Separate - bundle each type individually
	<u>Milk & Juice -</u> Carton/Boxes	Rinse, flatten, box or bundle
