Acceptable Waste

- Asphalt Pavement
- Concrete
- Stone
- Uncontaminated soil
- Masonry (bricks, Stucco and plaster)
- Untreated wood
- Siding
- Attached wall coverings
- Electrical wiring and components
- Roofing materials
- Duct work
- Wall board, sheet rock
- Built-in cabinetry
- Plumbing fixtures
- Attached carpet and padding
- Attached other flooring materials
- Conduit and pipes
- Window and door glass (from buildings and structures)
- Insulation
- Molded fiberglass
- Rubber
- Drain Tile
- Metal
- Ceiling tile

For any items not listed, check with the operator before placing in a load.
Any unacceptable waste (with some exceptions) can be disposed of in the
Transfer Station for an additional fee.
