- Building materials (dirt/cement/rock/wood)
- Food boxes
- Mirrors
- Plastic toys
- Toothpaste tubes
- Waxed paper
- Wax cardboard boxes
- Carbon paper
- Cat litter
- Dishes
- Disposable diapers
- Food waste
- Shoes/clothing (any cloth materials)
- Sponges
- Soiled paper plates
- Soiled napkins/paper towels
- Soiled kleenex
- Soiled toilet paper
- Sanitary napkins
- Window glass
- Batteries
- Light Bulbs (especially fluorescent bulbs)
- Filters
- Furnace Filters
- Styrofoam/packing peanuts
