

Hunting In a Wadena County Park or on Public Land in Wadena County

- Hunting on public land, that land which is in holding by the county, is allowed.
- Hunters may not build permanent stands or blinds on public ground.
- Stands or blinds must be portable in nature and must be removed after each use.
- Target practice shooting is prohibited at all times of the year.
- Hunters may not have in their possession, out of doors or within a motor vehicle, within the boundaries of, or on the premises known and designated as a Wadena County Park, any kind of firearm or muzzle loading gun, during the period from May 1st until the day after Labor Day of each year, unless it is completely unloaded and contained in a gun case specifically designed for that purpose and is fully zipped, snapped, buckled, tied or otherwise fastened, with no portion of the contents showing, or is unloaded and contained in the trunk of a motor vehicle and the trunk door is closed and locked.
- Hunters need to be aware of their proximity to the designated camping areas at all times and need to exercise extreme caution in the direction they are firing.
- Hunters are responsible to know where public land ends and where private property begins.
