

Finding Court Forms

Online:

The State Court Administrator's Office in St. Paul has now posted statewide forms on their public website. You can find and download the forms at www.mncourts.gov

In Person:

Forms obtained directly from Court Administration will have a cost. Form packets that have 10 pages or fewer are free, but 11 pages or more will cost \$5.00.

Divorce packets (divorces with or without children) will be \$10.00 each.

Probate:

Probate includes wills, estates, guardianships, psychological commitments, etc.

With a few exceptions, the court system in Minnesota generally does not produce its own probate forms. However, private publishers do provide many of these forms for a small charge. One of those publishers is Miller Davis and forms can be located at www.millerdavis.com

Tax Court:

In Minnesota, Tax Court is separate from the regular State Trial Courts. You can find forms and information at www.taxcourt.state.mn.us/forms.html
